In April of 1993, I was given the chance to join the

seminars conducted by Tomekichi Taike. Since then, I devoted myself entirely to the practice he conveyed through those gatherings—*"Look within your own heart."*

Mr. Taike left this physical world in December 2015. He spoke to us with passion, again and again, that learning is life itself. True to his words, he wholeheartedly conveyed the world of truth to all who came to the seminars.

The fact that I was allowed to learn the world of true vibration with Mr. Taike, and together with him, is an unshakeable reality within me. That reality gave me unwavering conviction.

The more than twenty years I was able to learn under him and with him—those years are truly irreplaceable. They are my treasure. That is why I never allow his intention to be wasted. The only thing I must do is to nurture within myself the world of vibration he conveyed. I always return to that point and confirm my path.

Over those more than twenty years of participating in the seminars, there are things I have learned and felt directly with my heart.

And in time, this awakening will arise within the hearts of all people.

So please—listen now.

Listen to our message within your own heart.

All the functions of your body will stop at that moment, and if the body is left as it is, it will eventually decay.

Of course, in today's society we do not simply leave the body; it is cremated, leaving behind only bones and ashes.

But are those bones and ashes truly you?

Most people think so.

That is why they scatter ashes in the mountains or the sea, why they fight over bones, why they enshrine them as if they

were something sacred.

Yet, isn't it strange—almost absurd—to call out to someone who has become nothing but bones and ash, asking them to watch over us from heaven?

Some may say, *“Even though the body is gone, that person lives on in our hearts.”*

If that is so, then why do we place our hands together before the family altar? Why do we visit graves?

If the one who has died lives within our hearts, then what purpose does the altar serve?

Who is it that sleeps in the grave?

When you follow these questions, do you not sense a contradiction?

Something that does not quite add up?

Or they may live for the moment, driven by a sense of futility.

Those who are not healthy may also believe that death is the end, and think that dying will free them from their present suffering—leading them to choose death themselves.

Even if they do not go that far, they may live in despair, forced into a life of emotional collapse or reckless abandonment.

To those who are healthy and to those who are not, I wish to speak simply and plainly.

I want to convey how foolish, how pitiful it is to believe that the single visible body you see is truly yourself—and that all human suffering originates from this mistaken belief.

I want to speak honestly from the thoughts that rise within my heart:

“People, awaken to your true form.

Meet the one who is truly you.”

This is the first thing I would like you to know.

So please understand the universe as energy.

Earlier, I wrote that I am not the small physical form of flesh, but energy.

Yes—I am the energy called the universe.

And that same universal energy exists within you as well.

Has it become confusing?

You may think this sounds incomprehensible, but please stay with me a little longer.

You believe the one physical body you have now is yourself.

But I write this book because I wish you to come to know, within your own heart, that this is not so.

More than that—you will feel in your heart the exhilaration of setting yourself free, more and more.

When that begins to happen, you will also come to realize that even the word “*heart*,” as you have understood it, was interpreted far too narrowly.

When you begin to sense within your heart that such a universe is your very self, the way you see the world around you will surely begin to change.

The everyday scenery you always look upon will appear somehow different—felt differently.

This may be a sign that the wind of the universe has begun, ever so softly, to stir within you.

And eventually, within you, something—something you cannot yet name—will begin to move, begin to change.

You may interpret this as touching a version of yourself so distant that your present self cannot even imagine it.

Yes—the universe truly exists within you.

That is the call I am making to you now.

Perhaps humanity's longing for the universe—its eternal dream and romance—is actually the voice of humanity itself beginning to awaken from a deep, deep sleep.

No—in the time to come, we will pass through that very process.

Together, these three volumes clearly present the foundations of the learning that Tomekichi Taike conveyed over more than thirty years—

in other words, the correct steps of the study.

Please begin by learning these correct steps through these three books.

And once the foundation is firmly understood, what remains is practice.

Practice is indispensable for coming to understand, within your heart, the true essence of the learning.

Following the correct steps, through the right practice of meditation, I ask that you direct your thoughts not only to the one physical form you now possess, but also to the countless universes that exist within your heart.

Surely, those universes will teach you:

Why you are here.

What it is you truly wish to do.

The universes within you—countless versions of yourself—will teach you.

If you learn to turn your thoughts toward your own heart, you will come to know yourself.

Now, as for me, I do not live each day by seeing only this physical form that is visible now.

Of course, to maintain this body, food and sleep are necessary.

And in today's world, a certain level of clothing, food, and shelter require money.

Money is needed, to a degree, to obtain goods and services.

But in this lifetime, I have decided that I will no longer be a slave to money, nor allow money to distort my life.

This is because, as I said earlier, I no longer live by seeing only the visible “*me*,” thinking only about that “*me*,” and directing all my thoughts solely toward that “*me*.”

Naturally, when I go about my daily life, my thoughts turn outward.

However, I have the habit of meditating.

Meditation is the time when I turn my thoughts inward,

not outward.

I make sure to have such time every day.

And when I turn inward, I feel the many versions of myself speaking.

These many selves, of course, have no physical form.

Without a body, they also have no “mouth” with which to speak.

Yet their thoughts are conveyed to me.

Through meditation, I feel within my heart that I carry many versions of myself.

I feel, in my daily meditation, that countless universes exist within me.

If I were to put this into words, it might sound like this:

Please listen to a portion of the thoughts of the universes that reach my heart.

I am not a special being.

The same kinds of thoughts are surely being conveyed within your heart as well.

I want you to communicate with the universes within you.

Communication with the universes is not something grand or dramatic.

Please do not reject it from the outset by saying, *“I don’t understand the universe.”*

Do not cut it off.

Breathe through the tanden, and then call out, in your heart, to the universe.

But do this while firmly observing the desires within yourself.

What is important is this:

With each breath into the tanden, feel a sincere joy in the present moment, and quietly call out within your heart, *“Universe.”*

That is what I always do.

That is how I always call forth the universe within me.

While feeling joy that my mother’s consciousness granted me this physical body, I call to the universe within me.

Gently, I turn my thoughts in that direction.

Do not tell yourself that you cannot understand or feel it.

It is surely being conveyed to you.

You are only blocking it.

When you say *“I don’t understand”* or *“I don’t feel anything,”* it is only you shutting it out.

The universe within you is speaking—continuously.

Please listen to those thoughts.

Just as your mother’s consciousness accepted you, please accept your universe.

Let your heart turn toward the self that has wandered endlessly through the far, far distant past.

As you continue meditation, the thoughts that brought you to Earth in this lifetime will reach your heart—

perhaps faintly at first, but surely.

When that happens, speak to yourself:

“I’m happy... From here on, let us turn our hearts together.”

Let that feeling gently expand within your heart.



We, the universe, are you.

And you are we, the universe.

You now possess one physical body, and you have believed that this one body is yourself.

From the standpoint of the visible physical body, it appears that many separate people exist.

But in truth, we exist in one world.

We are unseen, without form—and that is who you truly are.

This is the first message we bring to you.

As we said earlier, you came into this three-dimensional world by transcending dimensions.

And now the time has come when you will once again leave this three-dimensional realm.

We express this as dimensional transition.

We, the universe, are telling you that Earth humanity—consciousnesses who have taken physical form on this planet—are now approaching that time.

You came into this three-dimensional world in order to know yourselves while holding a physical form.

But humanity has never looked into its own heart, never sought to know itself as energy, as consciousness.

Humanity has continued until now without doing so.

“It is not so. Look into your heart.

*Come to know that you are not the form, but consciousness, energy.
That is why the present moment exists.”*

This is what we, the universe, have long wished to convey.

We, the universe, will continue to send warnings to Earth humanity.

*Did you not take on physical form in order to look into your
own heart?*

Look at the heart that has lived only for its own desires.

Please feel our thoughts.

1. What is Amaterasu?

Once again, let me repeat: the universe is energy.

Countless energies converge in the universe.

You could say that the convergence of these energies is the universe.

Among them there is one called Amaterasu.

You may know of Amaterasu Ōmikami, the sun goddess of Japanese mythology.

But what about Amaterasu, written in katakana?

Though Amaterasu and Amaterasu sound the same, the scale of the two is worlds apart.

Amaterasu of myth is a world created by human beings.

From the perspective of Amaterasu, that world is truly tiny.

No—it is human beings, who have taken form as the absolute reality, that have made it so small.

Out of their own desires, they created the divine world of Amaterasu.

They created a world where people join their hands, plead, and cling in prayer.

Though they themselves once existed in a world that spread

out without limit, they came to bow down before that tiny world.

So then, what is Amaterasu?

I have called it “one of the energies that has ruled the universe.”

Yes, Amaterasu is energy.

What kind of energy?

Put simply, it is the energy that has forgotten warmth, gentleness, and peace—

and that has opposed warmth, gentleness, and peace.

It has waged relentless war.

It raised the banner of “myself above all,” placed everything other than itself under its control, and ruled over it.

It has existed constantly in the midst of conflict, seeing everything but itself as an enemy.

Naturally, it is alone.

In unfathomable loneliness, Amaterasu had no choice but to keep raising itself up.

What it needed was power.

Ever stronger, ever more exalted, it thrust itself upward, fighting without end in order to stand at the very pinnacle of all things.

This is the true nature of the energy called Amaterasu.

Consciousnesses that sought power from this world of Amaterasu, and that became its lackeys,

each created within themselves a divine world of “I alone am supreme.”

One such example is the deity Amaterasu.

To this energy of Amaterasu, the one who came to call out, “Recognize your true form. Return to your true self,” was the world of consciousness of Tomekichi Taike and Albert.

2. The Awakening of Amaterasu

In this lifetime, the world of consciousness of Tomekichi Taike and Albert used the one person named Tomekichi Taike to convey the message:

“The true form of human beings is consciousness, energy.”

In this way, through each of our physical bodies, the universes, too, learned.

Among them, the energy that had especially extended its influence throughout the universe was Amaterasu.

And the realization and awakening of Amaterasu was the single most important point of the seminars in this lifetime.

Or rather, in this lifetime there was, from the beginning, a plan: that the great energies represented by Amaterasu would catch a glimpse of their true form and then steadily draw closer to their own truth.

The execution of that plan unfolded when the consciousness of Tomekichi Taike and Albert came into three dimensions and began holding seminars.

That plan is now progressing extremely well.

Why?

Because the awakening of Amaterasu—
who had abandoned warmth, denied it, and sunk to the
very bottom of darkness—

is about to set great movements into motion in the world of
consciousness, in the universe.

In time, the movement in the world of consciousness will
appear in the world of form.

The first clear sign of this will be the sinking of the
country of Japan.

Japan has long been called the “land of the gods,” the land
of Amaterasu.

Amaterasu took upon itself the full force of Amaterasu’s
energy, and everything was offered up to that presence.

However, in this lifetime, Amaterasu encountered the
world of true vibration—

the world of Tomekichi Taike and Albert—

and was shocked by the smallness of the world over which
it had ruled.

It was stunned by the poverty, the foolishness of the
domain in which it had reigned.

At the same time, that world crumbled away like a fragile
illusion.

Indeed, Amaterasu was shocked to see its own world
collapse—

but it did not fall into despair.

Because through that collapse, it came to know that its true

Whether it be Amaterasu, or Jesus, or any other deity,
human beings will refuse to let go of the divine worlds they
have believed in—until the very end.

Therefore, upheavals will inevitably occur in this three-
dimensional world.

A consciousness that has awakened to truth—
that has touched the world of true vibration and awakened
itself—

is what I now refer to as the energy of Amaterasu.

That energy will carry out the work of joy
throughout the entire universe, including Earth.

That is the energy of upheaval—what you call cataclysms.

The consciousness of Tomekichi Taike and Albert is now
working upon the entire universe, including the Earth.

Touched by that energy of joy, that energy of love, one
consciousness after another awakens, and, in the form of

upheaval, urges others to awaken.

no matter how much you seek salvation, no matter how long you continue to pray, you will no longer be able to stop the speed of collapse.

When I think of the universe, I am simply, deeply happy.
With my heart packed full of many universes, with my
heart packed full of dark universes,
even so, I can still return to that vast universe of warm warmth.
This is what I now convey to myself.
The universe is my companions.
To turn my thoughts toward that universe is joy.
Now, it is joy for me to turn my heart there and feel that

we truly communicate.

It is enough just to think “universe,” and then the thoughts of my companions come through to me.

I feel how I have swallowed countless universes into my heart.

I feel myself who has continued to exist through truly boundless time and space.

And as those thoughts come with me and I turn my heart still further, I find there the very universe to which we longed to return.

Every time that feeling reaches my heart, true happiness and joy overflow.

Earth, thank you.
With joyful thoughts, we are sending this message strongly,
strongly from our hearts.
Thank you for receiving our thoughts.
From now on as well, please, please keep receiving our
thoughts, more and more and more.
Receive our vibration.
Joy will spread— across the whole Earth, and across the entire
universe.”*

Ah, I am happy.

I am now firmly receiving this thought.

It is we who are seeking to return to Mother Universe.

For a long time I had wanted to talk with the universe— to have heart-to-heart communication.

That wish has now become reality and is spreading within me.

When I think of the universe in my heart, I feel the joy of the consciousnesses

*"Ah, Mother...
the universe was within the Mother's warmth.
Ah, Mother...
is it Ama-terasu,
is it Bashar,*

is it Amandor,

is it Lucifor?

For me, the names do not matter. Only the joy that is conveyed into this heart matters.

We were Black energy that had reigned in the universe, and now we truly convey joy.

I can feel joy spreading in my heart.

Mother's thought spreads out.

This thought has changed my universe.

within me that I am ever drawing nearer to Truth.

There is no final goal in the world of consciousness.
